## **ORDER**

In Partial modification of D(Estt.I/Gp.II)'s Order No. A-14011/01/2008-D(Estt.I/Gp.II) dated 18<sup>th</sup> December 2017 regarding nomination of Liasion Officers to ensure due compliance of the orders of reservation issued from time to time in favour of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Persons with Disabilities (PWD) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) in Ministry of Defence, the following Liasion Officers are nominated in the Department of Defence for the employees of MoD(Sectt.), the staff of Defence Accounts Department, the civilian staff working in the lower formation of Armed Forces and allied organizations like EME, DGDE, MES, etc.

a) Shri Surendra Kumar, DFA(AG)/Fin

: for SCs/STs/PwDs employees of DoD

b) Shri Sunil Kumar Pal, DS(BR-II)

: for OBC employees of DoD.

- 2. The above mentioned Liaison Officers will
  - a) ensure due compliance by the subordinate authorities with the reservation orders and other benefits admissible to SC(s)/ST(s)/PWD(s)/OBC(s).
  - b) scrutinize and ensure prompt submission of the prescribed annual statements by the appointing Authorities to the Ministries/Departments and consolidation of the annual statements and sending such consolidated statements to the Departments of Personnel &Training.
  - c) scrutinize properly all proposals for dereservation and to certify after due satisfaction that such dereservation are inevitable and that all steps prescribed in this regards have been faithfully taken.
  - d) liaise between the Ministries/Departments/Attached and Subordinate Offices and the Department of Personnel for supply of required information, answering queries and clearing doubts.
  - e) conduct annual inspection of the rosters maintained, keeping a record of such inspection in prescribed proforma.
  - f) extend necessary assistance to the Commissioner of SC(s)/ST(s)/PWD(s)/OBC(s) in discharge of his/her duties and functions.
