**FAKE ALERT MESSAGES ON PASSWORD RESET EMAILS**

1. It is intimated that fake email message which appears to be sent from a gov.in domain user has been received by this office. The contents of the mail, contains a phishing link in order to fool the intended recipient with a malicious intent. The details of the sender email IDs, subject and message being displayed are as follows:-

Message	Dear User, Someone has recently tried to reset your password. View activity immediately and follow instructions to prevent from illegal access. <u><a href="#">Click here to view activity</a></u>  With Regards, Messaging Administrator National Informatics Centre

In view of the above, it is advised that all users must exercise caution while operating their personal as well as official email IDs and not to open any email attachment / click on links in received emails without confirming the genuineness of sender and email content. In case of any doubt, this office may be approached for advice / clarifications.
