 - (c) he is a person of ability, integrity and standing having special knowledge of, and professional experience of not less than twenty years in, economics, business, commerce, law, finance, accountancy, management, industry, public affairs, administration or in any other matter which in the opinion of Central Government, is useful to the AFT."
- 3. In terms of the said schedule 18 (column 5&6) to the Rule 9, term of office of the Member is for three years and the maximum age for holding the office by the Member is 65 years.
- 4. Salary, allowances, other terms and conditions of the Members of the AFT, shall be governed by the provisions of "The Tribunal, Appellate Tribunal and other Authorities (Qualifications, Experience and other Conditions of Service of Members) Rules, 2017."
- 5. The selected persons are liable to be posted to anywhere in India having a Bench of the Armed Forces Tribunal and the appointment shall carry an All India transfer liability.
- 6. The information and material pertaining to the following categories are required to be enclosed along with the application/bio-data in the prescribed format for the post of Administrative Member in the Armed Forces Tribunal:-
